When We Sail and How to Get There

Embarkation Hours and Pier Locations

You must check in at least 30 minutes prior to departure or risk automatic cancellation of your reservation.

(For Hawaii cruises from Ensenada, motorcoach transportation from and to Los Angeles and San Diego airports is complimentary.)

The cruise terminals can be reached by cab from hotels, airports, bus terminals and railroad stations. Guests are responsible for identifying their own baggage and ensuring luggage is on the transport carrier to the vessel. Guests who do not purchase Carnival's Fly Aweigh program have the option of purchasing airport/pier one-way or round-trip transfers for the day of embarkation and debarkation. This service is available only during normal operating hours. Advance reservations are required 7 days prior to sailing. Please visit carnival.com or contact your travel agent for details. Guests who do not purchase transfers are responsible for all transportation to and from the pier.

Where to leave your car

Secured outdoor parking facilities are available at each port of embarkation. Parking fees vary by port (average \$10 per day), and are payable to the parking attendant. Parking facilities are independently operated.

Baggage Assistance

Curbside porters are available at the pier to take luggage to the vessel for delivery by shipboard personnel to your stateroom. Customary tip is \$1 per bag. Please be sure each piece of luggage is locked and has a tag listing your name and stateroom number. Curbside porters are not employees of Carnival; therefore, if you experience any problems, please report them to porter management on site. Any luggage left at the pier will be forwarded at your expense. Claims for luggage loss or damage must be made in writing to the embarkation personnel prior to leaving the pier area.

In some ports you may carry on your luggage if it does not exceed 24"w x 16"h. Please check upon arrival at the terminal. Carnival assumes no responsibility for carry-on baggage.

We highly recommend that guests personally carry any valuables, medication, breakable items and boarding documentation (passports, visas, I.D.) on and off the vessel.
