Shore Excursions

Participating in a shore excursion is the best way to get the most out of your visit to each port of call. It relieves you from having to make your own sightseeing arrangements and gives you the opportunity to see the highlights. Carnival constantly upgrades the shore excursion packages to make sure the best possible selections are available. Your choices range from island sightseeing trips to fun-filled Jeep® adventures, horseback riding, snorkeling and many other exciting activities.

All guests with a fully deposited "Fun Ship" cruise booking can pre-purchase shore excursions up to six months prior to the sail date by using their booking number to register online at carnival.com/shoreexcursions. Once registered, you will have access to all of the shore excursions and pricing applicable to your specific itinerary. Pre-purchased shore excursions will be confirmed online at carnival.com and tickets will be delivered to your stateroom on the first day of the cruise. Review your tickets carefully, paying special attention to the meeting place and departure time as this information may have changed between the time of booking and your sail date.

Shore excursion descriptions and ordering information can also be found in your stateroom. Further information can be obtained at the Shore Excursion Desk as well as the Information Desk in the main lobby. Your Cruise Director and Shore Excursion Manager will hold an informational Travel Talk during the cruise. Please consult your Carnival Capers for time and location.

Please note all excursions are operated by independent on-shore vendors and are sold on board as a convenience to our guests. Guests engage in all activities off the vessel at their own risk.

Boarding Card and Ship Access

Your Sail & Sign card will serve as your boarding card. This card identifies you as a Carnival guest and must be carried with you, along with picture identification, when you go ashore. Since the ship is closed to the public while docked at the various ports of call, you'll have to show your Sail & Sign Card and picture I.D. to the officer on duty in order to return on board.

Will I have any problems with money ashore?

U.S. currency and travelers' checks are accepted in most ports of call we visit. Store owners will honor most credit cards, but personal checks are not usually accepted.

Can I use the ship in port?

Yes, by all means. While in port, your ship is still your home, and you should feel free to leave or return any time of day or night. Think of it as your home away from home.
